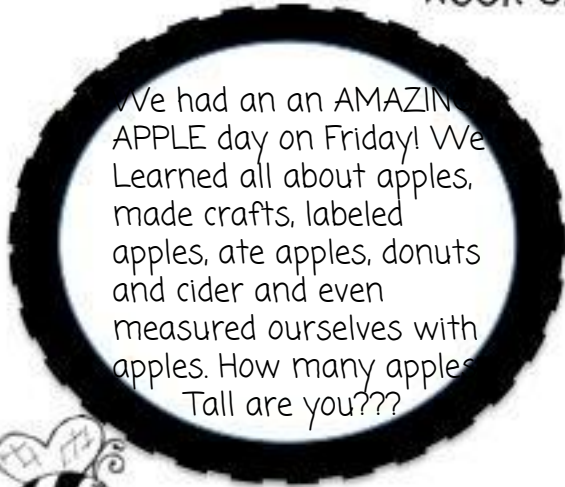


Snapshot of Our Week
