Highlight of our week

Math

In math, students are learning how to independently make "Math Menu" choices. They are playing games to practice number bonds, $+1/-1$, "building numbers" on ten frames, and counting. They are also doing number writing, fast math practice sheets and showing their learning with exit tickets.



Science

Our ants have been doing great! We learned so much about being scientists while studying them! We learned that scientists write and draw, study with tools like magnifying glasses and clipboards, experiment, use labels, and make predictions.



Literacy

In Reader's Workshop, first graders are exploring habits for building stamina. We know what independent reading looks and sounds like, how to use our reading mats to make piles of "just right books" and "sight word cards."
