Highlight of our week



Math

In math, students are continuing to practice number formation, counting, and listening to, and creating math stories to solve addition problems up to 10. Ask your child to create a math story! We are learning that good problem solvers read the problem, draw, write and circle their answer.



Literacy

In Reader's Workshop, first graders are exploring habits for building stamina. We know what independent reading looks and sounds like, how to reread books, how to ask 3 before me, and how to shop for new books.

In Writer's Workshop, we practiced starting with an uppercase letter and ending with a period. We also learned about "think, plan, write"- a method good writers use for starting stories.
